Craig’s leadership journey started when he became an Eagle Scout at age 14. Thirty years later he was the **youngest General in the U.S. Army.**

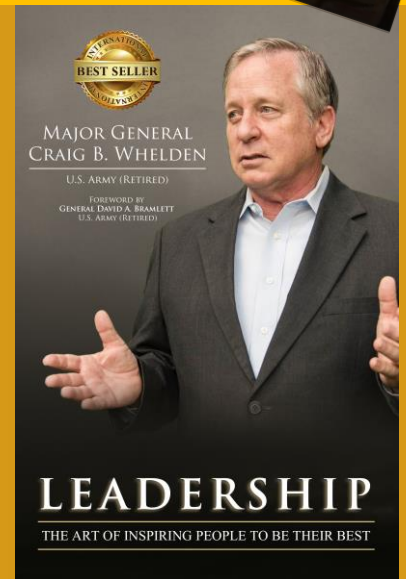
